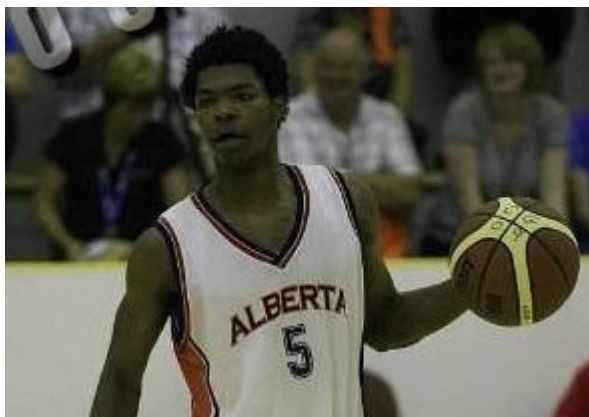


SAHR SAFFA

MITCH BUFFIE



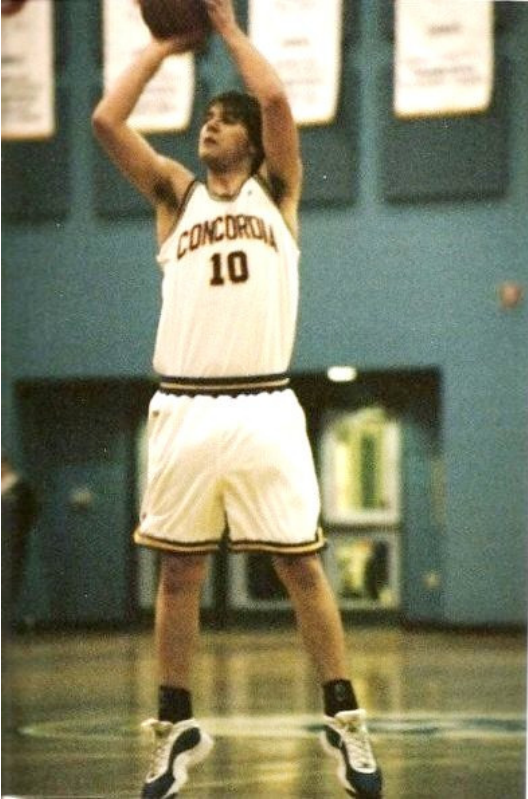
